## WHAT



The Sexually Transmitted Infections Foundation Course (STI Foundation) is designed for adult learners who want to improve their knowledge, attitude, and skills in the management of sexually transmitted infections, and to know when and how to refer to specialist services.

This is a multi-disciplinary course aimed at doctors, nurses, registered midwives, physician associates, health care assistants who may provide contraception/STI advice, and secondary care clinicians (who may encounter patients with STIs e.g. obstetrics and gynaecology, rheumatology, ophthalmology, A&E etc.) and sexual healthcare professionals wishing to undertake STIF competency training and assessment.
