

Introduction

The Wolverton Centre is a Sexual Health Clinic specialising in sexually transmitted infections (STIs), HIV, contraception and specialist genitourinary medicine services (for example genital skin conditions).

Established in 1995, the centre continues to grow in popularity, with attendances now exceeding 25,000 a year. The department moved in November 2008 to modern, attractive premises on the Kingston Hospital site.

No referral is required to come to the service. You can attend either a booked appointment or come to one of the walk-in clinics.

Staff are specially trained and experienced in all sexual health issues and are non-judgmental, friendly and approachable.

On-site facilities are available for performing sexual health screens, with many results available immediately. All treatments and antibiotics are free and issued directly from the clinic.

Your Confidentiality

Patient confidentiality is very important to us. All information provided will remain confidential. Your notes are kept within the centre and all information you provide is protected by law.

This means no information will be given to anyone without your consent. This includes GPs, parents or guardians and partners.

Services available at the Wolverton Centre

1) Sexual health

- Testing & treatment of Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) & HIV testing, advice & counselling
- Advice, information and counselling for sexual health related problems.
- Specialist support for anyone who has concerns including sexual exploitation, violence, sexual assault, FGM, recurring STIs, drugs/alcohol support.

2) Contraception

We offer a full range of contraception including implants, coils, injections, the vaginal ring & patch.

3) Specialist Services

- Consultant-led sexual health services for patients with more complex sexual health & contraception needs including genital skin conditions, genital pain, psychosexual problems and complex coil problems.
- “The Point” - a sexual health and contraception clinic especially for 18 year olds and under, held every Tuesday 4:00–7:00 pm.
- “LGBTQ” - a sexual health clinic for those who identify as LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer / Questioning) held every Wednesday evening 5.00–7.00 pm.
- “Connect” - a sexual health service for people of all ages, with learning difficulties including Autism and Aspergers, held every Wednesday afternoon.
- Counselling - experienced clinical psychologists provide clinics for psychological issues related to sexual health/HIV.

4) HIV Service - Integrated outpatient & inpatient medical care and treatment for those who may have been exposed to HIV (PEPSE/PEP)

How to find us

The Wolverton Centre is situated at the front of Kingston Hospital on Galsworthy Road, near A&E, just by the Emergency Ambulance entrance. Whilst facing the hospital’s main entrance, turn right and walk to the end of the hospital site (past A&E). (Hospital map on the back of this leaflet)

We strongly advise you use public transport. Hospital parking is very limited and you will need to use the Pay & Display car parks. Alternative parking may be available in residential roads.
